

## Property Committee

This was an active year for the property committee with the following projects getting done:

The rectory has new windows, siding, gutters, remodeled bathroom on second floor and extra dirt to bank up the foundation. Father Torey and Jacquie painted the bedrooms, dining room and the main floor bath was refurbished. Storm door on west side was replaced.

We again did a spring cleaning of the terrace area, we lost several rose bushes and may lose more with the winter we've been having. The roses and shrubs were professionally trimmed thanks to the Rodawig family. We need to decide if we're replacing the roses or going with something else. Church family input would be helpful here.

The drain in the east parking lot of the church was repaired.

Sacristy closet was redone.

Stove vent in church kitchen was repaired by Frank Post who also had a friend give some advice about the boiler system.

As with any old historic home there's always minor repairs to be done but we have some large repairs we need to be thinking about. We're still fighting water leaking in along the north side of the church causing problems in the ladies bathroom and along the wall. We extended the downspout drains and that has helped some on the south and east of the church. There is plaster falling down near the organ in the church and we need to find where it may be leaking and repair so that we can then re-plaster and paint.
